- a) Scholarship is available to an applicant who meets the following criteria
- Is a full-time college student (undergraduate- 12 credits/semester, graduate - 9 credits/semester), who is currently enrolled in a college or university located in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, or South Carolina in a two year, four year or a graduate program (see item 2 above) and demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
 - High school senior who has applied and been accepted in a full-time U.S. college or university located in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, or South Carolina (see item 2 above) with accreditation recognized by the U. S. Department of Education, and who also demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- b) Applicants must be a citizen or permanent resident of the U.S.
- c) Applications for the current scholarship award will be accepted between October 1, 2018 and November 30, 2018 (for the school year 2018-2019).
- d) Be a THSOA member in good standing.
- e) Applications will be reviewed by THSOA-Southeast Chapter Education Committee.
- f) Scholarship winners will be announced by December 31, 2018.
- g) Currently, for 2018-2019 academic year, awards are expected to be:
4 x \$1000.00 scholarships.
- h) Selection will be based on a combination of academic performance, letters of recommendation, and answers documented in the application process.
